- → Nassau County School District has received an overall "A" rating from the Florida State Board of Education and is ranked #1 out of 67 districts in Florida
- → The district includes some of the highest-rated schools in Northeast Florida
- → The Nassau School District graduation rate is 92% compared to the state average of 90%. Every year, Nassau County Schools work towards a graduation rate of 100%
- → For 12 straight years, Nassau County Schools have been designated an Academically High-Performing District by the Florida State Board of Education
